GPX has helped build healthy, strong, and confident athletes. Athletes learn about sportsmanship, working together towards goals, and striving to win. The teamwork athletes gain from our program is a valuable lifelong lesson.

Today, more than ever, the world needs more cheer. Cheer, conversely, offers hope, purpose, and community. It boosts self-esteem and it inspires, empowers, & frees. It unshackles children from society's constraints & expectations and it never judges... except for those two and a half minutes on the competition mat.

### **TEAM PLACEMENTS**

The athletes will demonstrate all that they have learned and the coaches/assistants will convene to a meeting. After the evaluation process is complete you will receive an email informing you what days/times to attend team placement workouts.

### **EVERYONE MAKES A TEAM!**

Our summer schedule is to learn skills and drills. After our CAMP Session we will begin to put together our routine.

### PRACTICE/ATTENDANCE

All competitive teams have a regular two practice days per week schedule. Typically, two practices will be held during the week. Mandatory practices begin in July and our season runs through May; please count on an additional team practice. Practice times usually remain consistent throughout the season and are only changed as needed. During important times of the season, extra practices may be scheduled. These practices are typically scheduled well in advance and all athletes are expected to attend.



# COST/TUITION/TEAMS

Competitive cheer, while not as costly as some youth activities, can still be expensive. Before considering GPX or any program, please consider the financial and time commitment involved. GPX All Star Cheer has our very own cheer gym, where we train our athletes. Being a traveling, competitive sport our prices are similar to the other traveling sports in our area.



# **Parent Information**

Parent's Role

The parent's participation and commitment to the team is critical! We know that this is a huge financial and time commitment, but it is a commitment that is worth every cent and minute!

We need the parents to make sure the children are at practice on time, and properly dressed for practice as well as for competitions, camps, fund-raisers, etc. Athletes must wear practice attire, with hair in a high pony with a bow. No exceptions. If you are unable to get your child to practice, use the buddy system and contact a student that may attend your school. It takes a village to raise children and all parents understand. If something comes up and your child is unable to attend practice please text Alicia (307) 680-0591.

The coaches expect full cooperation and backing from all parents. If you are not in agreement with decisions made by our staff, please schedule a time to discuss any issues in private.

All athletes and parents are responsible for checking our Facebook group or **Band App** for any updates or changes to the schedule. This is the best way to stay in communications with the whole team. There is no excuse for being uninformed or irresponsible when the information has been provided.

- Attend and be prepared to participate in all activities including those unexpectedly added throughout the season regardless of illness.
- All practices are mandatory.
- Notify Alicia in writing immediately of all expected tardiness or absences. TEXT Message Please
  - MISSED PRACTICES ARE A HUGE ISSUE IN OUR PROGRAM; UNLIKE MANY SPORTS WE WORK AS A TEAM SO IF ONE PERSON MISSES IT PUTS OUR WHOLE TEAM OUT.
- If you will miss practice due to illness, you must inform your coach via text or FB Messenger as soon as possible. Failure to do so may result in the loss of your routine spot. Please if you have symptoms of illness, severe cough, fever or vomiting contact Alicia ASAP via text message before coming to practice or performances.
- If you are injured you need to come to practice to mark your spot and watch to make sure no new moves are added. Please provide a doctor's note detailing your restrictions.
- If you miss practice, you are responsible for learning any new material. We will post frequently on Facebook/band app new stuff.
- Move, replace, add, suspend, or even dismiss an athlete for a period of time or indefinitely from a team including but not limited to: attendance, conduct, skills, etc.

### **DRESS CODE**

- Wear their designated attire, socks, and sneakers.
- o all girls must have tennis shoes at practice or you will sit out.
- Keep hair out of the face (if possible, in a high ponytail) and wear a bow at all times unless otherwise instructed.
- Keep nails shorter than fingertips.
- Remove all jewelry

### SPORTSMANSHIP/CONDUCT

- Set a positive example for others to follow.
- Be respectful and courteous to everyone.
- Be a positive role model on social media. Any negative or inappropriate content can cause removal from the team.

GPX All-Star athletes and parents/guardians must, at all times, be a strong representative of GPX All-Star Cheer program and a positive reflection of his/her teammates. Abusive, uncontrollable, irresponsible or any other form of negative behavior will not be tolerated. Negative responses, lack of productivity and disrespect will not be tolerated and will be grounds for alternate status or dismissal. If a team member is removed, becomes ill or injured and is unable to perform, he/she will be replaced by an alternate or appointed substitute. Fraternization between athlete and coach will not be tolerated.

### REMINDERS/BEHAVIOR DURING TEAM PRACTICES

Practice time is very valuable and every minute is important. Therefore, cheerleaders will follow these guidelines at all GPX practices.

- All Cheerleaders must arrive on time for practice and be ready to begin at the designated time
- Cell phones must be turned OFF before practice begins and left in the assigned area.
- We strongly encourage teammates to support each other at all times. Supporting each other will bring out the best in all athletes and will motivate everyone to maximum potential! Cheer on, yell and push your teammates, remember we are all in this together.
- We expect all of our athletes to work hard at each and every practice. There may be times of frustration; this is when you can count on your coaches and teammates to help you out.
- Negative attitudes towards teammates and/or coaches or program will NOT be tolerated.

### FUNDRAISING / SPONSORSHIPS

Fundraising helps to defer some of the costs incurred as a member of the cheerleading program. We strongly encourage you to participate in various fundraising events throughout the year. We will coordinate the Fundraising activities for the year. Feel free to give us any suggestions. With effort and organization fundraising can go a long way to help cover the cost of your children. We will have different types of fundraising. Individual fundraisers will be applied directly towards your other fees. Group fundraiser & Business sponsorships will go to GPX fundraising account to help with cost of new gym equipment. If you do not wish to participate in the fundraising activities there will be a fee that you can pay instead.

# 2023-2024 GPX Agreement (https://forms.gle/aKAfnnLuQFvQCuyH8)

We view All Star cheerleading as a sport like any other. Coaches make decisions for the good of the team in terms of practice schedules, meetings, team placement, and roles in the routine. Teams are formed based on age and skill level. In general, elite tumbling at each level is required and stunting position/skill strongly influences team placement. This form will be digital on google forms that you will have to fill out! This is just for your records.

All fees are DUE on the 1st of every month for the whole season and all delinquent fees are	
subject to a \$25 late fee if payment is not made. (7-day grace period)	
Payments will be made by cash, check, or online payment via Jackrabbit	
I understand that attendance will be a large component of cheer. There will be	
mandatory practices 1 week preceding a performance and my athlete(s) are required to be in	
attendance.	
I understand that every practice is mandatory and missing may result in a consequence	
for my athlete i.e., running, take out tumbling pass, moved to back, etc. If my child misses, I	
understand that this impacts the entire team and she/he could be moved, placed as an	
alternate or released in severe cases.	
If there is some emergency (i.e., hospitalization or death) and my child cannot attend	
practice, I must get in touch with her team coach prior to that practice. If my athlete is injured	
I agree to send her/him to practice in order to watch and to ensure any changes are understood.	
I understand that negativity toward coaches, athletes or parents will not be tolerated; both in the gym or via	
social media. Social media will be monitored. If anything does occur, I understand I will be given one warning	
and then asked to leave the program.	
I understand that the coaches have the right to close practices as they deem necessary.	
I understand that if I have an outstanding balance after 30 days, my athlete may be	
asked to sit out of practice. I also understand that if I have an outstanding balance after 60	
days, my athlete(s) may be asked to leave the program.	
I understand my athlete(s) will not be eligible for private lessons, unlimited classes, and	
receipt of uniforms, practice clothes, or items I may have paid specifically for, if my account is in	
negative.	
I understand that I will forfeit any monies paid if I choose to leave a team or if I am	
asked to leave the program for any reason. I will be responsible for fees that would be incurred	
for the next 30 days following my athlete's departure.	
I have read and fully understand all policies, rules and expectations in the Registration Packet. I understand	
that I am entering into this All-Star program on my own free will. I understand what is expected of me as a	
parent and All-Star cheerleader. I will conduct myself in a sportsmanlike manner and uphold the standards the	าลเ
